Notice to Enter Private Property for Topographical Survey and Geotechnical Investigation








Figure 2: Benson Street Sewer Replacement, Reading, Ohio

We are writing to inform you of upcoming field investigations that the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) will be conducting in your neighborhood related to future sewer improvements. The objective of these improvements is to improve system capacity and reduce system overflows from sanitary sewer overflow #1001 located on Benson Street (see Figure 2).


The improvements include the installation of approximately 4,100 linear feet of new gravity sanitary sewer, ranging in diameter from 12 to 24-inches. This new sewer will be installed in the existing sanitary sewer alignment, requiring the older sewer to be removed. Figure 2 depicts the proposed alignment of the new gravity sewer.

MSD will be sending field crews to your neighborhood to conduct topographical surveys and geotechnical investigations beginning in August 2012, between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Topographical surveys and geotechnical investigations are essential steps in our design process.

During the investigations, crews will be taking engineering measurements of the existing infrastructure as well as drilling geotechnical borings in the vicinity. It may be necessary for crewmembers to enter your yard to access areas not visible from the street. Under Ohio Law (Section 6117.01 (F), Revised Code of Ohio), MSD must provide property owners with written notice before entry onto private (or public) property. Please consider this letter to be that written notice. When possible, a crewmember will attempt to notify you prior to walking across your property.

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In the event that MSD needs to enter your house to obtain a basement elevation, you will be contacted one week prior to the survey to set up an appointment for the measurement. All personnel will be carrying a copy of this letter, along with an identification badge (examples provided below in Figure 1) that identifies them as MSD representatives. Please do not allow anyone into your home without the notification letter or ID badge.


